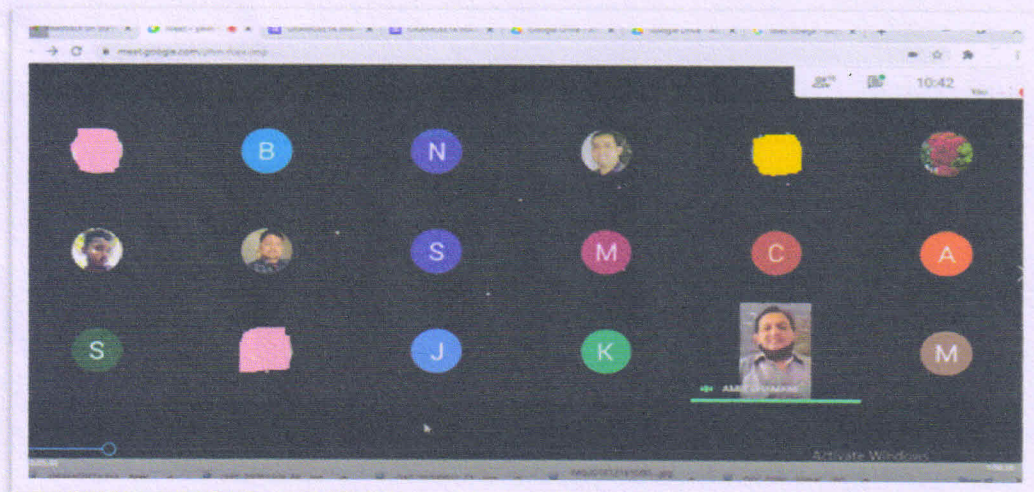
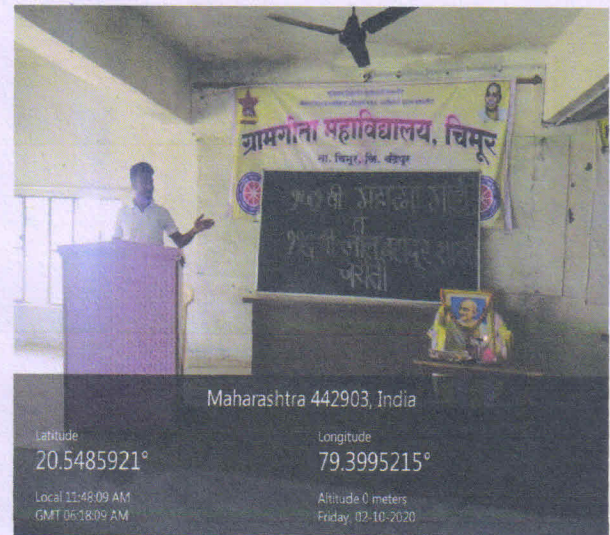
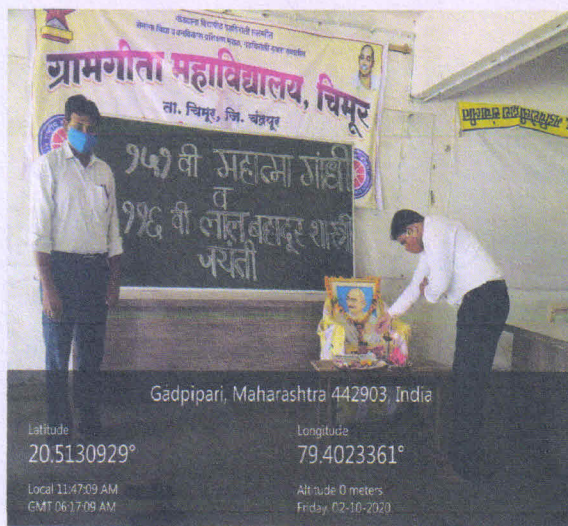
Report on celebration of Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti and Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti

Date – 3th January 2021

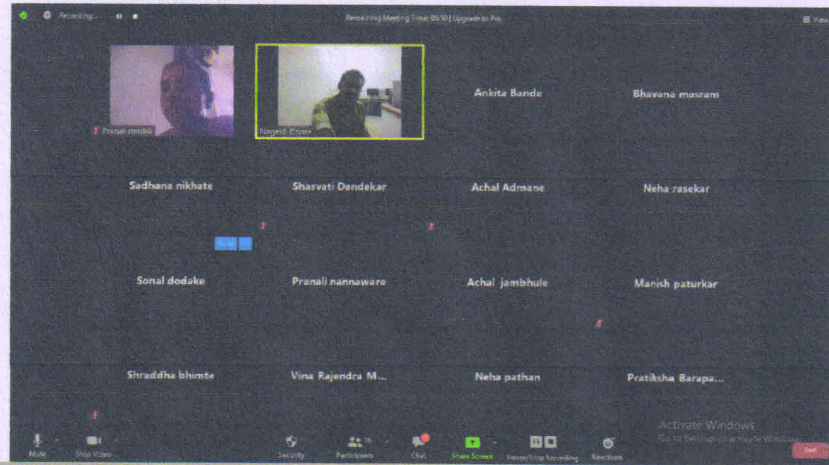

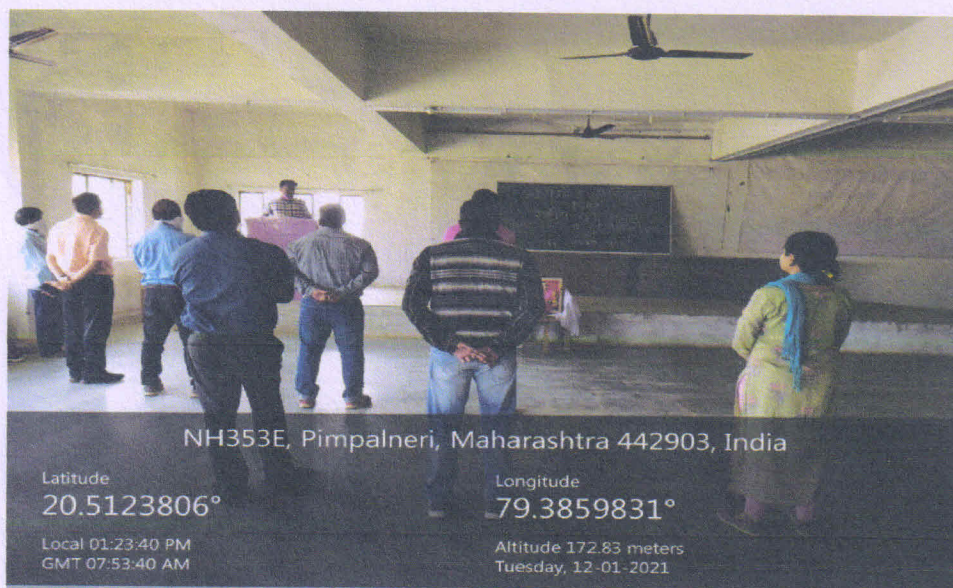


Report on celebration of Yuva Divas


Karishma Sonkusare student of college gave wonderful speech on International women's day , and she praised for the working women's.



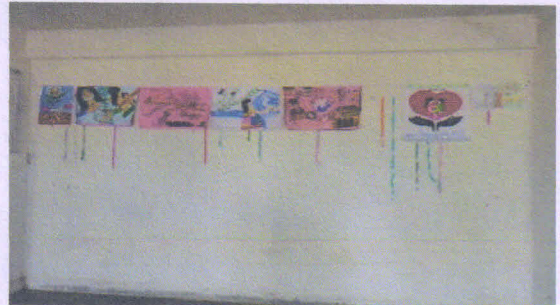
4. Helping Campaign for Sangli and Satara Flooded Victims:

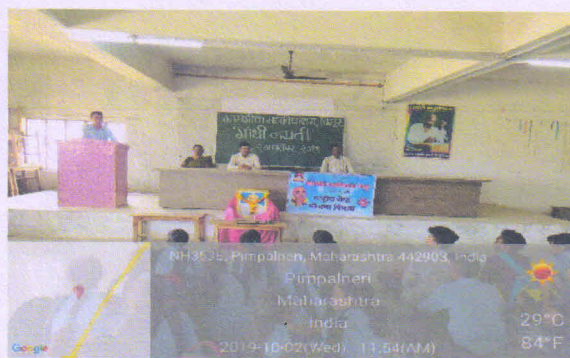

10. Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Death Anniversary

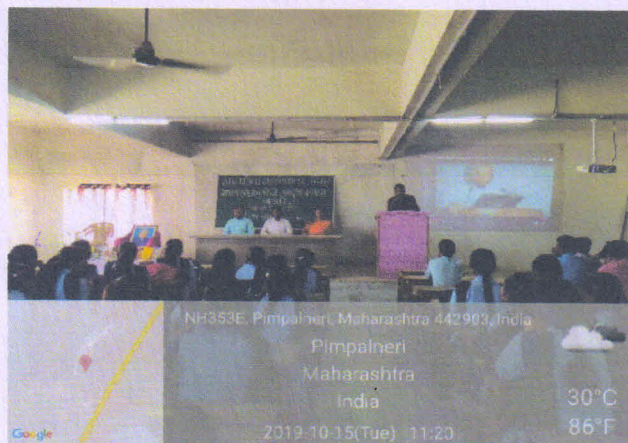

22. National Youth Day:



14. Savitribai Fule Birth Anniversary:






15. Rashtramata Jijau and Swami Vivekanand Jayanti:

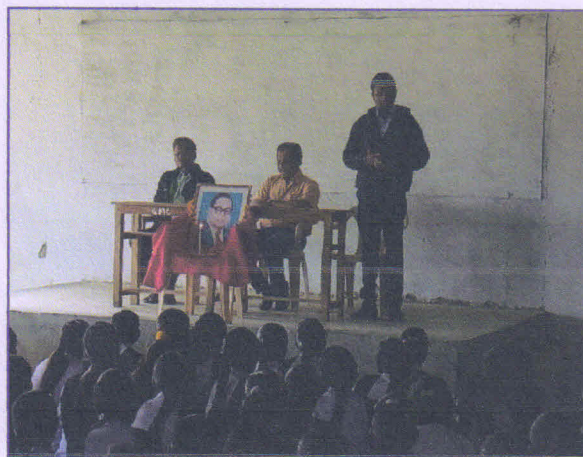
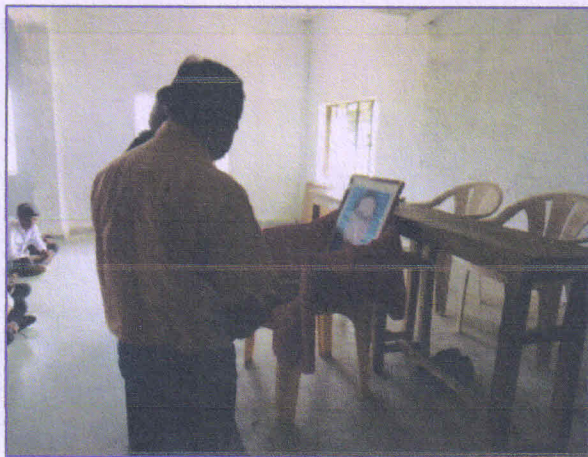
5. Report on celebration of Savitribai Phule Jayanti

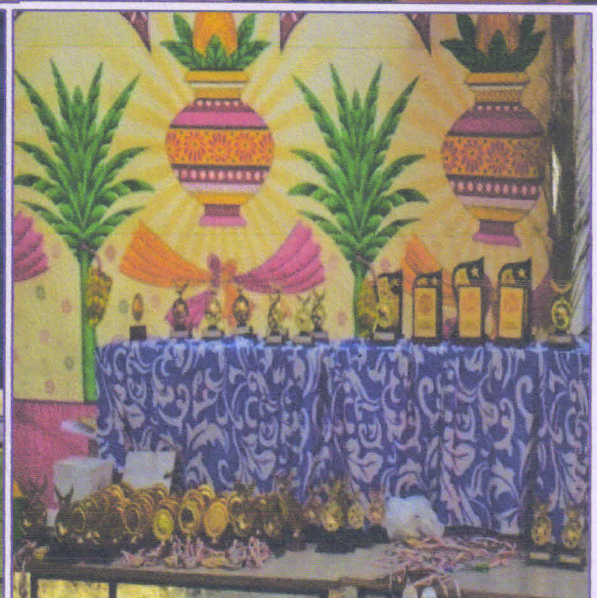





