Date -8th march 2019(International Women's Day)

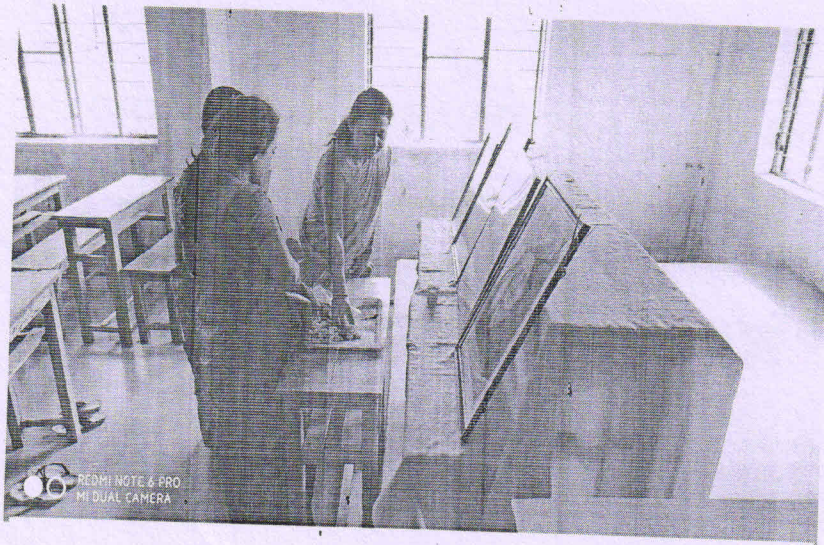





The seminar was held on 8th march2018 at seminar hall of Gramgeeta Mahavidyalaya, Chimur.

Mrs. Khati very warmly welcomed all the participants for being a part of the seminar on women's empowerment. She made everyone recall that one of the major contributors to the Indian society has been the active participation of some of very focused and dedicated women who brought social reforms like Savitribai Phule, Sarojini Naidu to name a few. She also spoke about the women in position of power, breaking the glass ceiling.

Miss. S. S. Gajbhiye addressed the various issues faced by women in all walks of life. She spoke about how the sex ratio is skewed in favour of the men and said that gender sensitization cannot be complete without sensitizing the men. She addressed the issue that political power is still a male domain in India. She said that the glass ceiling for the women can be broken only collectively. She said that although women are visible in the grass root levels, their presence is scarce at the top management. She also addressed the rampant issue of female foeticide which are still prevailing in the society.

Dr. Bharati Satpaise spoke about the role of women in politics. She highlighted that there is secondary status for women in every field. The condition in developing countries is even worse. Many in-laws do not like their daughters-in-law working. There is a common adage that a girl only works for her own pocket-money. She also raised the issue that women are perpetually excluded from decision making at every step of the ladder, starting from the household to the top layers of policy making. She emphasized that women should be happy and satisfied, which is a basic requirement of every human being.

Dr. A. A. Dhamani, Principal of the college in his presidential address first compared yesteryears and present-day college environment, sharing some real life experiences. He also spoke about the fact that only women deal and speak about issues related to women is a categorize in itself. The number of struggles for women is immense, be it at the home front or due to there not being a provision for catering to the stress of active and outdoor reporting or not being given desired beats for coverage.

On this occasion we also felicitated ex-students of our college who secured highest marks at P.G. level. Miss. Shikha Jaju scored highest marks at P.G. Degree in the subject Mathematics from R. T. M. Nagpur University and miss. Shamal Talewar who scored highest marks at P.G. level in the subject Physics from Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.

Chair person of programme Dr. Amir Dhamani wished for the success of workshop and inspired the participants for various activities.


